

Rally Set at Battle Creek

ROCHESTER, Mich. — "A Day in God's Army" is the theme of the Youth Rally set for Aug. 28 in Battle Creek, Mich., according to Bob Miller, field representative of Michigan Christian College.

Battle Creek was the scene of the Tri-State Youth Rally last November when over 700 young

people were in attendance.

The Rally will be held in the Harper Creek High School building beginning at 12:30 p.m. and concluding at 9:30 p.m. The 20th Street church of Christ will serve as host for the occasion.

The day's program will be planned and led by Bob Miller under the sponsorship of Michigan Christian College.

He said that the program is designed to be "different, dynamic, and exciting" and "a program which no young person in the area should miss." The emphasis is on "recruiting an army for Christ" and will feature special activities on three phases of the Christian warfare.

These phases are: ministry by personal evangelism, ministry by communication and min-

istry in foreign missions.

The youth, who will attend the Rally mainly from the states of Michigan, Indiana, Illinois and Ohio, will be divided into three "arms" of service: (1) the Army, emphasizing personal work; (2) the Air Force, relating to communications; and (3) the Navy, emphasizing foreign missions.

Each group will participate in "Basic Training," "Maneuvers" (spiritual war games), Youth Chorus, group singing, and other activities.

A drama has been planned for the evening program after a supper featuring an unending supply of Italian spaghetti.

The day's activities will conclude with inspirational campfire devotions and a parting challenge to youth to give their lives in service to Christ.
