The afternoon session of the DALNET meetings will include a number of staff from all DALNET Libraries. Documents librarians will be represented as documents are an important part of the DALNET database and now have a major presence on the WEB.

2. Horizon migration schedule—Randall Jones

R. Jones passed out project schedules for Univerity of Detroit-Mercy-DALNET and Wayne State University-DALNET. The current goal is to have:

UDM up by Fall Term, 1998 and

Wayne State and Detroit Public and a hospital library by April 1999

The hospital library would be Botsford.

Ameritech staff are investigating ways to compress the schedule so that these deadlines can be met. Steve Nielsen, Product Manager for Horizon, Jan Sheppard, (cataloging expert) and Valerie Chase (profiling expert) will be working with DALNET to assist in the effort. A major decision that has to be made is the choice between two structures:

One bibliographic record

Separate databases with multiple records

UDM has been working this past month on developing their profile and indexes. Their plan is complete and has been given to L. Bugg. They have addressed many issues and regardless of our choice creating indexes is critical to the process. Agreement on codes is also critical. One possible schedule might be: UDM live in AUGUST/SEPTEMBER

WSU in Jan

DPL in March

And hospital library in March

Technical matters that have to be addressed include: WEBPAC, Z39.50 hook ups, AADS for frame relay, equipment needs, wiring projects, network plan, patron validation, broadcasting feature (searching multiple databases), patron empowerment, training issues, Infoshare machine.

Ameritech is developing a system for the Union Catalog of all Cal State university catalogs. They will be linking 7 diverse library systems with 12 ½ million records.

In the next two days the DALNET Database Structure Task Force must come up with a recommendation to send to the Steering Committee and the DALNET Board.
