Further, please let me know what you think of changing the prompts generated by the so-called hook-to-holdings, as annotated and also enclosed, to try to at least subtly suggest to patrons that the "hook" goes to more than just one library.

Also, please come to the meeting with any reactions to the change in the Serials format's Brief view, and any other screens issues which arose during the Fall semester's heavy activity.

Finally, I'm hoping that you'll be able to bring or send to the meeting a brief description of your site's circulation policies -- a statement that would be suitable to be displayed online through an "explain" screen (something like "explain circ").
