2 courses Social Science-two disciplines.
2 courses Fine Arts/Humanities-two disciplines
2 courses Natural Science one lab-two disciplines.

Things to consider if we do not align transfer degrees to MTA

- Percentage of OCC students who transfer-50 % +
- Additional gen ed credits/impact on degree completion
- Potential impact on Financial Aid
- MTA endorsement without degree completion

Things to consider with aligning transfer degrees to MTA

- Increases the transfer friendliness of the degree, rather than just courses
- Increase in graduation rates
- Maximize transfer options/reduce costs
- Benefits

- Would aligning the Liberal Arts, Business Administration, Associate in Science degrees to include MTA requirements be most beneficial to transfer students?
- Pol 1510 is imbedded in the MTA Social Science list. Do we remove Pol 1510 as a stand alone course for an Associate's Degree and move it into the Social Science category on the General Education Distribution List?
