#### The State of Michigan now helps you give to MCC

Did you know that you can divert some of your tax dollars for the support of Christian Education? Yes. the Michigan Income Tax Credit can be used to support any of the 97 colleges in Michigan. Thank God we have a Christian college in Michigan and that the state will let you use part of your tax dollars to support it.

Most Christians in Michigan can give \$200 to \$400 per year to MCC and take half of their gift directly from what they would have paid in Michigan income tax. If your Michigan income tax for the year totals \$600 you can choose to give \$120 to MCC and cut your tax bill to \$480. To do this, you would give MCC \$240 during the year and claim half (\$120) as a credit when you file your tax returns. If payroll deductions

have already fully paid your taxes, the state will refund you \$120.

If your total Michigan tax is \$1000, you can give \$200 of your tax to MCC, cutting your tax to \$800. If your Michigan tax is \$300, you can give \$60 of it, (20% of your Michigan tax, up to a maximum of \$200 for a couple). To determine how many tax dollars you can direct to Christian Education, check line 16 of your 1979 State tax return ... assuming this year's income will be similar.

Since Michigan is encouraging us to support Christian Education, please resolve that you will divert every tax dollar possible to support Michigan Christian College.


