

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Rochester College is committed to providing financial assistance to ensure that you can receive a quality Christian education. Financial aid is available from many sources — Federal and State financial aid programs and RC scholarship opportunities — and we will assist you in obtaining all aid for which you are eligible. Transfer scholarships also are available based upon your GPA:

2.75 GPA \$2,000 per year
3.00 GPA \$2,500 per year
3.25 GPA \$3,000 per year
3.50 GPA \$3,500 per year
3.75 GPA \$4,500 per year

TRANSFER REQUIREMENTS

Students must have a cumulative GPA of 2.25 and transfer 16 or more college credits to qualify as a transfer student at RC. Transfer credit may apply toward a traditional degree, but is limited to no more than 34 semester hours toward the associate's degree and 98 hours toward the bachelor's degree. At least 50% of a student's major core requirements must be earned at RC. Transfer credit is not applied to your RC GPA. RC participates in the MACRAO Transfer Agreement.



STEPS TO TAKE

1. Fill out and submit an application online for free. You can find it at www.rc.edu/apply. Applications also can be turned in to the Admissions Office, 800 W. Avon Road, Rochester Hills, MI, 48307. Applicants who submit a hard copy will be responsible for a non-refundable application fee of \$35.
2. Provide an official transcript from all previously attended colleges or universities. Transcripts must be received and evaluated before an admissions decision will be made.
3. Get connected with our admissions team if you are considering a transfer to Rochester College in your future. We can help you plan your current class schedule at another institution to make sure you are able to transfer and receive credit for as many classes as possible.
