Ruth and Dave,

As I explained to Dave, the full report is not complete. However, the data collection you need is. I am attaching a spreadsheet including # of graduates, and number and percent that entered OCC after graduation, for each high school. Please note two factors regarding the data collection this year. 1.) We have always collected the number of Alternative Education Program graduates (if these graduates are not included in the existing number of high school graduates). Previously, if we had numbers for a district that the district would not allocate to the individual schools, we lumped the alternative ed grads in with a pre-selected high school. This year we allocated the alternative program grads based on the percentage of total traditional grads. The districts affected are Farmington, Huron Valley, Pontiac, Royal Oak, Troy, Walled Lake, and Waterford. 2.) As Dave may recall, there were some data entry errors last year resulting in an incorrectly low number of students entering OCC from some high schools, most notably the Farmington Schools. The increase in number of students entering OCC for some schools may be artificially high due to the data entry errors.
