**Executive Summary**

Following is the 2007-08 Annual Degree/Certificate and Credit Hour Summary Report. Included in this report are rankings and counts of all associate degrees and certificates awarded, as well as the total number of credit hours generated by course prefix.

This report can be summarized with the following main points:

- The college granted 1,956<sup>✓</sup> associate degrees and 232<sup>✓</sup> certificates during the 2007-08 academic year. Degrees awarded decreased 7.7%<sup>✓</sup>, and certificates awarded increased 5.5%<sup>✓</sup> over the previous year.
- Over 100 degrees were awarded in four programs: Liberal Arts (593)<sup>✓</sup>, General Studies (257)<sup>✓</sup>, Business Administration (203)<sup>✓</sup>, and Nursing (173)<sup>✓</sup>.
- Certificates were most frequently awarded in Paralegal (34)<sup>✓</sup>, Medical Assisting, Medical Insurance Coding & Billing (24)<sup>✓</sup>, Modified Career Ladder PN Program (17)<sup>✓</sup>, Medical Assisting, Phlebotomy (17)<sup>✓</sup> Baking and Pastry Arts (12)<sup>✓</sup>.
- Throughout the 2007-08 academic year, OCC provided 506,474 credit hours of coursework. This figure represents an increase of 2.6% in credit hours from the 2006-07 academic year.
- Over 10,000 credit hours were provided in ~~five~~<sup>fifteen</sup> subject areas:

Executive Summary

Following is the 2006-07 Annual Degree/Certificate and Credit Hour Summary Report. Included in this report are rankings and counts of all associate degrees and certificates awarded, as well as the total number of credit hours generated by course prefix.

This report can be summarized with the following main points:

- The college granted ~~1,816~~<sup>1,956</sup> associate degrees and ~~220~~<sup>232</sup> certificates during the 2006-07~~8~~ academic year. Degrees awarded decreased ~~0.4%~~<sup>7.7%</sup>, and certificates awarded increased ~~8.2%~~<sup>5.5%</sup> over the previous year.
- Over 100 degrees were awarded in four programs: Liberal Arts (~~555~~<sup>593</sup>), General Studies (~~255~~<sup>257</sup>), Business Administration (~~237~~<sup>203</sup>), and Nursing (~~143~~<sup>173</sup>).
- Certificates were most frequently awarded in Paralegal (~~27~~<sup>34</sup>), Medical Assisting, Medical Insurance Coding & Billing (~~23~~<sup>24</sup>), ~~Modified Career Ladder PN Program~~<sup>13</sup> (~~19~~<sup>17</sup>), Medical Assisting, Phlebotomy (~~18~~<sup>12</sup>), Baking and Pastry Arts (~~17~~<sup>12</sup>), and Emergency Medical Services, Basic EMT (12).
- Throughout the 2006-07 academic year, OCC provided ~~493,655~~<sup>506,474</sup> credit hours of coursework. This figure represents an increase of ~~1.2%~~<sup>2.6%</sup> in credit hours from the 2005-06 academic year.
- Over 10,000 credit hours were provided in ~~fifteen~~<sup>16</sup> subject areas:
