Executive Summary

Following is the 2010-11 Annual Degree/Certificate and Credit Hour Summary Report. Included in this report are rankings and counts of all associate degrees and certificates awarded, as well as the total number of credit hours generated by course prefix.

This report can be summarized with the following main points:

- The college granted 2,284 associate degrees and 384 certificates during the 2010-11 academic year. Degrees awarded increased 3%, and certificates awarded increased 21.5% over the previous year.
- Over 100 degrees were awarded in four programs: Liberal Arts (660), General Studies (292), Nursing (200), and Business Administration (172).
- Certificates were most frequently awarded in Paralegal (58), Medical Assisting, Medical Insurance Coding & Billing (32), Modified Career Ladder PN Program (25), Emergency Medical Services (24), General Accounting (20).
- Throughout the 2010-11 academic year, OCC provided 628,630 credit hours of coursework. This figure represents an increase of less than 1% in credit hours from the 2009-10 academic year.
- Over 10,000 credit hours were provided in each of nineteen subject areas:
